

Wedge-rumped Storm-Petrel

A Wedge-rumped Storm-Petrel was observed and described by an experienced seabird observer 325 km SE of South Point, Hawai'i I, 9 Oct 2010 ([HICEAS data](#)). Although thought likely to be correct, the [HBRC](#) opted not to accept this record to the Hawaiian Island Checklist. Wedge-rumped Storm-Petrels breed in the Galapagos Is and South American coast and ranges at sea coastally and into the eastern tropical Pacific, with records at least to 600 km SSE the Hawaiian Is (Pitman 1986, Spear and Ainley 2007).
