A report of a Royal Tern from Kealia Pond NWR, Maui 21 Feb 2002, did not have enough details to eliminate <u>Elegant</u> (*T. elegans*) or <u>Caspian</u> terns. Royal Terns occur along temperate Atlantic and Pacific American coasts, with vagrants recorded throughout N America and to Europe and Africa (AOU 1998). It could be a potential vagrant to the Hawaiian Islands.
